INDONESIA


MALAYSIA

HIROSHIMA

HAIPHONG - HANOI

Known as the “Rising Dragon”, the capital of Vietnam has maintained a poetic aspect and a nostalgic charm. The rapid urbanization of the city, a blend of past and present, has produced a new city of remarkable diversity. In Hanoi, you can find the mythical city of temples and pagodas, a trading city with its narrow streets and also a dreamy city with the mirror of its lakes. In Vietnamese, Hanoi means “the city between rivers” and it is the capital of the country, located in the North on the banks of the Red River. The historic dragon of Vietnam, elegant, refined Hanoi is revealing itself, with its European aspects and its Eastern air. Do not miss the mausoleum of Ho Chi Minh, the very beautiful One Pillar Pagoda and the Temple of Literature, dedicated to Confucius.



SAIGON RIVER

Bordering the former colonial district in the East of the city, the Saigon River gives Ho Chi Minh the image of a city that embraces its Delta and is open to the world. A majestic waterway located in Southern Vietnam, it takes its source near Phum Daung in the South-East of Cambodia, before meeting the Nhà Bè, to the South of the city. From the gardens that have been built along the Ton Duc Thang avenue, do not miss the ceaseless ballet of the fragile looking skiffs that sail their way past the huge cargo ships coming from Hong Kong and Taiwan. Enjoy the strains of traditional Vietnamese music and be seduced by the splendid scenery along the riverbanks.

CHAN MAY - HUE

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Hue is proud of its past and the regal origins of its ancestors. A picturesque city when the weather is fine, Hue is shrouded in mystery on less glorious days. The former capital of the Nguyen dynasty nestles in a bend in the Perfume River which flows in a valley between lush green hills. A number of landmarks testify to its former grandeur - you can visit the Imperial City, nestled within the walls of the Citadel and opposite the imposing Flag Tower, or the Thien Mu pagoda, who hurls his frail silhouette towards the sky. Further, discover the mausoleum of the Tu Duc emperor. Like all sovereigns, the Nguyen emperors were concerned with the eternity of their life on the other side, and they paid particular attention to the construction of their mausoleum.

DA NANG - HOI AN

Lulled by the quite waters of the Thu Bon River, Hoi An seems to slumber under a spell that made time stand still. This former port city was very prosperous in the 15th century, and rich merchants based their trading posts there, building sturdy wooden houses in bright colours with roofs of ceramic tiles. A sleepy and charming village will transport you back through the centuries to a time where sampans supplied the surrounding markets with a thousand and one products, perfumes and flavours. A wander through its car-free streets is the best way to travel through time and discover this gentle nostalgia which has earned it a place on the UNESCO World Heritage list.

AT THE HEART OF INDONESIA

From Singapore, we invite you to take a cruise to the heart of Indonesia. Set sail to discover the Lesser Sunda Islands, with larger-than-life Java, known for its perfectly dimensioned temples, and intoxicating Bali, "the Island of the Gods", with its landscapes of a rare beauty, seeming to have been delicately placed onto the turquoise waters of the Ocean. Lastly, chart a course east towards the Sunda Islands, edged with white sandy beaches and fringed with coral reefs.

SEMARANG - THE BOROBUDUR TEMPLES

Sandwiched between Sumatra and Bali, Java is an island with the most extraordinary diversity; nature has created superb terraced paddy fields hiding a thousand and one treasures. From Semarang, the former port town of the island, allow you to be guided along the path to enlightenment of the great temple of Borobudur, or Candi Borobudur, built in the year of the powerful Sailendra dynasty. This tranquil site, a fragment of mystery, nestled in the heart of lush vegetation, is both a sanctuary dedicated to Buddha and a fervent centre of pilgrimage, decorated with finely carved bas-reliefs where imposing sculptures. Veritable architectural and cultural masterpiece, but also the testament to its illustrious past, it represents one of the high points of Buddhist faith in Indonesia.



BALI

It would be tempting to ban visits to Bali just so that we can keep it a secret for ourselves. The "Island of Gods" is a constant source of charm and timeless beauty. Located at the Western tip of the Sunda Islands, between Java and Lombok, it is renowned for its artistic development in areas as varied as classical dance, sculpture, painting, leather and metal working. Bali is superb beaches, imposing volcanic hillsides covered with forest, terraced paddy fields that make the light dance, a lively and authentic culture and a remarkably friendly population. The Balinese have lost nothing of their charm or customs; we find the daily ritual of offerings in front of every store, on every bridge, at the entrance to paddy fields or in altars that adorn gardens. We should visit it, but visit it well, in order to protect the treasure that it represents.

SUNDA ISLANDS

Between the Maluku Islands and Borneo, Sulawesi, also known as Celebes, unfurls like an orchid with its many surrounding islands. One look at its shape is enough to understand that here, between inlets and mountains, the sea is omnipresent and bestows on this immense land the charms of a tropical paradise. Long considered as the refuge of the famous Bugis and Makassar pirates, on the spice route from the West to the East, this island chain with its thousand shades of green and blue offers its visitors long beaches of golden sand, high mountain chains and immense terraced paddy fields. The very dense equatorial jungle is home to a wide variety of wildlife such as the nocturnal Tarsier and a large number of flamboyantly coloured birds. The land of Indigenous people, still living the earth of traditional villages, the Sunda Islands encapsulate all the charms of Indonesia and are at times the backdrop for fascinating ceremonies.

FORMALITIES

FOR ALL CRUISES

The below information is current but subject to change at any time without advance notice from government authorities. Please consult your respective government agencies for visa and health information.

Passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond the completion of your trip. Passport must contain at least two completely clear, blank, unused visa pages for each visa required, not including any amendment pages. Visa pages with stains or ink from other pages in the passport are not usable. Guests who deviate from the scheduled embarkation or disembarkation port should research the foreign entry requirements for the port country. Due to government regulations, regrettably PONANT will have to deny boarding to any guest who fails to obtain the appropriate travel documentation for this trip.

SPECIFIC FORMALITIES

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- (1) **China:** mandatory visa to be obtained before the start of the cruise and valid for the entire duration of your stay within China. We recommend you start the necessary application process early. A copy of your visa must be sent to PONANT at least 30 days prior to cruise date.
- (2) **Hong Kong:** a visa is not necessary for Hong Kong. However, should you plan on staying in China before or after your cruise; you will need to obtain an individual visa for China.
- (3) **Vietnam:** entry and exit visa issued and charged onboard (65€ to date, subject to change), this visa will allow you to exit Vietnam up to 30 days after disembarkation.
- (4) **Indonesia:** visa delivered and charged onboard (65€ subject to change). This visa is valid for guests disembarking in Indonesia or continuing onto the following cruise.
- (5) **Solomon Islands:** visa obtained onboard for citizens of Australia, New Zealand, Canada, USA and in possession of a flight ticket out of Honiara. Guests continuing onto the next cruise (Honiara - Noumea) are covered by a blanket visa which is free of charge.



(6) It is recommended that you contact your health professional for any specific medical advice relating to travel through these regions of Indonesia, including advice on Malaria and dengue fever prevention.

IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS

- **Visas:** Before departure, please check carefully that your visas are valid for the right date and time spent in the countries in order to avoid unpleasant situations.
- **Sightseeing:** Some places can only be visited on foot. Also, sites may have stairs or require you to take off shoes.
- **Currency:** Plan to have US dollars in small notes as they are easier to use outside of large cities.
- **Medication:** If you have a medical treatment, do not forget your prescription.
- **Coaches:** road conditions are poor in certain countries. Timings are unpredictable due to heavy traffic conditions. The comfort of coaches cannot be compared to that of international vehicles and often lack suspension.
- **Guides:** PONANT is aware that the quality of guides is of utmost importance and puts all efforts in place to secure the best local guides available. Note that guides in Asia often have heavy accents. Several of our calls visit small and isolated communities where resources (transportation and guides) are scarce, resulting in higher prices.

As you will be visiting some very remote and isolated parts of the world, resources (transportation and guides) are scarce and may not be of the standards you are used to. We ask for your patience and understanding during these truly unique experiences as we share the lifestyle and cultures of these seldom visited people and places.
