

A Voyage Like No Other




Sunshine Seasons

Spring in Norway promises fresh air and an array of blooming Arctic flora as the winter snow melts. The Midnight Sun at summer's peak means 24 hours of glorious daylight, hovering just above the horizon even at midnight. In autumn, the lush landscapes are drenched in a special golden light, accentuated by the layers of changing leaves.

Norway's Coastal Kitchen

Ingredients for the delectable dishes we serve on board are plucked straight from the surrounding sea and landscape. Sourcing our produce as fresh as can be from local suppliers is something we're really proud of. Your taste buds can expect sumptuous catch-of-the-day seafood, tasty venison, pork, and mutton, as well as cloudberry-infused desserts and other delicious treats.



Itinerary

DAY 1 | Tromsø

Fly into Tromsø, capital of the Arctic, via Oslo from London or Manchester airports. Depending on your flight time, you can visit the Polaria Aquarium and Museum, or take the cable car up 421 metres above sea level to the mountain ledge Storsteinen for superb views over Tromsø and its landscape. Enjoy a three-course dinner on us by the dock at the Scandic Hotel before boarding your Hurtigruten ship.

DAY 2 | Tromsø to Stamsund

The islands of Lofoten and Vesterålen are outstandingly beautiful. Charming fishing villages are sprinkled across the archipelagos, at the foot of jagged mountains and next to deep blue waters.

Tromsø to Stamsund optional excursions:

A Taste of Vesterålen (all year round) – beautiful scenery from Harstad to Sortland, including Trondenes, the world's northernmost medieval church – from £85pp

Sea Eagle Safari (24 Mar to 15 Oct) – head to Trollfjord from Svolvær to see these kings of the skies up close as they circle the boat – from £112pp

Lofoten Islands (9 Apr to 31 Aug) – see the scenery and appreciate archipelago art in a former caviar factory in Henningsvær – from £85pp

Lofoten by Horse (all year round) – mount up on Icelandic horses to discover secluded sandy beaches and views across the islands – from £108pp

RIB Adventure in Lofoten (9 Jun to 8 Sep) – hop aboard for a tour of the islands, Trollfjord, and Skrova fishing village – from £108pp

Fishing Village Walk (1 Sep to 8 Apr) – a guided walk on Svinøya island with an opportunity to taste locally made stockfish – from £51pp

Fishing in Lofoten (9 Apr to 8 Jun) – take part in the ancient Atlantic cod harvest aboard a local fishing boat amid the islands – from £81pp

Mountain Hike in Lofoten (9 Jun to 8 Nov) – view the islands from above and the mountains up close on this hike to Rørvikskaret – from £71pp

DAY 3 | Bodø to Rørvik

The landscape continues to impress along the Helgeland coast with the Seven Sisters mountain range and Torghatten with its distinctive hole; the result of an arrow fired by a troll, according to local legends.

Bodø to Rørvik optional excursions:

UNESCO Vega Archipelago (10 Jun to 9 Sep) – 6,500 islands form this archipelago, ancient centre for traditional eider down production – from £170pp

Brønnøysund Village Walk (all year round) – guided tour to see Brønnøy church and sample some delicacies from local producers – from £46pp

Visit the Salmon (10 Jun to 9 Sep) – learn about modern aquaculture from roe to fish, with fresh salmon tasting included of course – from £66pp

DAY 4 | Trondheim to Ålesund

Explore the Royal City of Trondheim, Norway's first capital and third largest city. Check out the views from the fort, or stroll around the old wooden Baklandet district with its eateries and coffee shops.

Trondheim to Ålesund optional excursions:

Trondheim with Nidaros Cathedral (all year round) – the 11th century Gothic-style cathedral is Norway's largest medieval church – from £49pp

Trondheim City Walk (all year round) – join this guided tour around the city to learn about its thousand-year-old history – from £40pp

The Atlantic Road (11 Apr to 10 Sep) – this rising and curving feat of engineering is one of Norway's most visited icons – from £119pp

Bergtatt – A Magnificent Marble Mine (15 Sep to 30 Apr) – enter the mine via a boat trip across an illuminated cave lake – from £153pp

DAY 5 | Bergen

Fly back to London or Manchester. Depending on your flight time, you can visit Bergen's UNESCO Bryggen district or nip up to Mount Fløyen on the Fløibanen Funicular for a beautiful cityscape view.
