All cruises (even cruises that do not visit foreign ports) require international travel insurance. We strongly recommend that you organise your travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit.

You should not base your insurance decision on the assumption 'it won't happen to me' – accidents or illness can happen to anyone. Hospital bills can cost more than AUD5000, or equivalent, per day. For further information or to purchase travel insurance:

You can view prices and pre-book excursions for your cruise from 120 days until seven days before sailing via 'Cruise Personaliser'. As numbers are limited, we recommend you book early. You can also book at the Shore Excursions desk once on board.

### I have limited mobility; can I go ashore in all ports?

It is important to note that access to tender ports may be restricted, which may also limit your excursion options. Do not worry if you cannot go ashore, a range of activities are available onboard!

### Can I organise gifts or celebrations before sailing?

We can help you celebrate your honeymoon, birthday or anniversary onboard with one of our special occasion packages. You can also arrange a gift such as a bottle of wine or flowers for a friend, loved one or even yourself, up until five (5) days prior to departure. For information on these packages, search 'Special Occasions' on our website.

### Can I get married or renew my vows onboard?

Yes, let Princess Cruises® help you create memories to last a lifetime. We offer a wide variety of special packages for weddings and vow renewals on most of our ships. Visit our website for more information or to download a brochure.

### How much luggage can I bring?

We recommend no more than two (2) bags per person. Each bag can be no bigger than 140cm x 60cm x 40cm and cannot weigh more than 32kg. It is important to remember that airlines may have different luggage restrictions.

### Can my friends and family see me off?

Family and friends are welcome to share in your excitement and wave farewell from the cruise terminal. Due to security reasons, they will be unable to come onboard with you.

## WELCOME ABOARD!

### What's included in my cruise fare?

Your comprehensive cruise fare includes onboard accommodation, ocean transportation, all main meals onboard, some non-alcoholic beverages and most entertainment. Excluded are meals at some alternate dining venues, meals on hosted land tours unless noted otherwise, transfers and items of a personal nature such as, but not limited to, spa services, shore excursions, beverages and some snacks, photographs, gratuities and medical services. Other services may be available at the time you sail, as we are constantly striving to enhance our product.

### What do I wear onboard?

During the day, casual clothes are suitable. After 5.30pm, smart casual attire is required in the public lounges and restaurants or as published in the ship's newsletter. On formal evenings, we suggest gentlemen wear a suit, or jacket and tie, and for ladies an evening or cocktail dress.

### How many formal/theme nights will there be?

Cruises up to 14 nights duration usually feature two or three formal nights, cruises up to 28 nights duration usually feature three (3) or four (4) formal nights, while longer cruises feature a minimum of five (5) formal nights. Please refer to your 'Cruise Personaliser' for specific information on your cruise.

In addition, Sun Princess® usually features theme nights on cruises seven (7) nights or more. There are also theme nights on Sea Princess®, Diamond Princess® and Golden Princess® cruises seven (7) nights or more, departing from and returning to Australia. These theme nights may vary from cruise to cruise. Themed accessories may be purchased onboard. You will be notified of the themes once onboard through the ship's newsletter.

### What is the currency onboard?

All prices onboard Sun Princess®, Sea Princess®, Diamond Princess®, Emerald Princess® and Golden Princess® cruises departing from and returning to Australia are in Australian Dollars. Prices onboard all other Princess Cruises® ships and Diamond Princess® cruises departing from and returning to Japan are in US Dollars.

### How do I pay onboard?

At embarkation, you will receive your personal 'Cruise Card', which will also be your security pass and door key. Yet another convenience of sailing with Princess Cruises® is being able to simply present your 'Cruise Card' and sign for all purchases. An itemised onboard account will be delivered to your stateroom at the end of your cruise.

We recommend that you pre-register your credit or debit card details online with 'Cruise Personaliser' or at embarkation for an express check-out. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Diners Club and AMEX. **A 1.1% service fee will be charged for guests settling their onboard account via credit card.** Debit cards act as a credit card, whilst using the available funds in your bank account. When using credit or debit cards, we obtain pre-authorisations and some banks hold these for up to 30 days. This may appear as a double charge to your credit or debit card until your bank releases the hold.

If you do not have a credit or debit card, you can activate your onboard account with cash or traveller's cheques, by paying a minimum deposit of AUD300 per person on Sun Princess®, Sea Princess®, Diamond Princess® and Golden Princess® cruises departing and returning to Australia or USD300 per person (CAD, GBP and EUR currencies are also accepted) on all other Princess Cruises® departures. Pre-paid credit cards and Travelex Visa cash passports are not accepted onboard.

For all round world cruises, shipboard accounts being settled by credit or debit card, will be settled in full and charged to the nominated card at the end of each published sector. We recommend you make arrangements with your card provider prior to the cruise to settle your personal card accounts whilst you are away.

### Do you have ATMs onboard?

Yes, ATM facilities are available onboard all our ships.

### Can I do my laundry onboard?

Our ships provide laundromats for self service washing and ironing. Laundry services are also available. Charges apply for these services.

### Are there safety deposit boxes?

Yes, there are safety deposit boxes located in every stateroom.

### Are there queen beds available?

Most staterooms can have queen beds, as long as the upper beds are not in use.

### What type of electrical sockets are onboard?

Sun Princess® and Sea Princess® cruises departing from and returning to Australia feature standard Australian plugs providing 220 volts AC at 60 hertz. All other Princess Cruises® ships feature American two-point plugs providing 110 volts AC at 60 hertz.

For safety reasons, we ask guests not to use their own electrical appliances onboard, except electric shavers and approved medical equipment.

### Should I bring my hairdryer?

Why take up extra space in your luggage, when we have a hairdryer in every stateroom.

### Is there duty-free shopping onboard?

Yes, we offer incredible tax and duty free savings off suggested retail prices on fragrances, cosmetics, jewellery, gifts, apparel, accessories and liquor. In accordance with regulation from the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service, our onboard boutiques will remain closed during coastal cruises. Guests joining an international cruise ships only to travel between Australian ports are not entitled to duty-free benefits or concessions. ### Is there a doctor onboard?

Yes, please refer to the 'Your Health' section in our 'Terms & Conditions'.

### What should I do if I suffer from motion sickness?

You can consult a healthcare professional prior to boarding, and prepare by purchasing medication or special magnetic wrist bands before you leave home. Motion sickness can also be treated onboard; medication is usually available for purchase and treatment can be provided by the ship's doctor.

Any charges from the onboard medical centre will be added to your 'Cruise Card' and you will be provided with an itemised account to submit to your travel insurance company.

### How do I keep in touch with home?

You can make calls from the phone in your stateroom, or use the ship's computers/wireless connections to keep in touch by email and internet. Please note, access is subject to satellite coverage and charges are higher than on land.

### Can I use my mobile phone?

Mobile phone reception is available onboard all of our ships. A compatible mobile phone and a service plan capable of roaming internationally with Maritime Communications Partners (AS) is required. Make sure you check with your service provider for applicable charges before you depart.

### How do I make arrangements for dining room seating and special dietary needs?

Seating arrangements in the dining room are made by request on a first come, first served basis. Requests for Anytime Dining™, traditional first or second seating, special diets or seating with a specific party should be made at the time of booking. Please note, Anytime Dining™ is not available on Pacific Princess® and Diamond Princess® cruises departing to and returning from Japan. Anytime Dining™ will be available Sea Princess® from 19 September 2017.

### What is gratuities (tipping)?

During your cruise, you will meet many members of our staff in a variety of locations as they provide you with impeccable service.

Tipping is not required or charged to your onboard account for Sun Princess®, Sea Princess®, Diamond Princess® or Golden Princess® cruises departing from and returning to Australia. You are welcome to reward our onboard crew for exceptional service, however, tipping is not required.

For all other Princess Cruises® ships, to save you the worry of who to tip and how much, a gratuity will be automatically added to your onboard account and may be adjusted or removed at your discretion onboard, as follows: USD13.95 for mini-suites and suites, and USD12.95 for all other staterooms, per guest, per day (including children).

This charge will be shared amongst those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including the wait staff, stateroom stewards, buffet stewards, galley staff, laundry staff and others.

### What is the bar and wine charge?

On all Princess Cruises® departures, except Sun Princess® departures, or Sea Princess®, Diamond Princess® and Golden Princess® cruises departing and returning to Australia, a 15% service charge is automatically added to any beverages purchased. This service charge is shared amongst the beverage staff and their support team, including cleaners and utility workers.

### Where can I smoke?

Smoking is only permitted in selected areas on our ships. These areas will be communicated to you onboard.

## OTHER BITS AND PIECES

### I have booked through a travel agency; can I still contact you directly?

Your Travel Agent is the expert in arranging your holiday. While we are happy to discuss general information about your cruise, we are unable to discuss any aspect of your booking with anyone other than a representative of your travel agency. Please contact your Travel Agent for specific details, requests or to make changes to your booking.

### When is GST payable?

GST is included in all Australian domestic voyage fares, flights, transfers, hotel packages and for Australian domestic shore excursions.

# terms & conditions

## 1. Introduction

These, and the Booking Details, are the terms and conditions under which you book your cruise holiday and travel on any Princess Cruises® product we sell you. Once you make a payment towards your cruise, you become bound by these terms and conditions, so it is important that you read them carefully.

We/Our/Us means Carnival plc, trading as Princess Cruises® and, where the context permits, includes the Carrier. PCL means Princess Cruise Lines Ltd, a Bermudan company. Carrier means PCL, except for bookings on Sun Princess® where Carrier means Carnival plc. In selling you cruises and issuing you tickets, Carnival plc acts as a sales agent for PCL, except for bookings on Sun Princess® where Carnival plc acts as principal. For bookings on Sea Princess®, Golden Princess® and Diamond Princess® cruises departing and returning to Australia, Carrier means Carnival plc and Carnival plc acts as principal in selling and issuing your tickets.

You are entering into this contract with Carnival plc trading as Princess Cruises®, ARBN 107 998 443.

Certain laws such as the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth) and any applicable state based consumer legislation (from here known as 'consumer laws'), are in place for your protection. They are designed to ensure the services provided by us (and, where applicable, the Carrier), are provided with due care and skill and are reasonably fit for a cruise holiday. These 'Terms & Conditions' do not alter any protection given to you by consumer laws.

All prices are correct at the time of publication and are quoted in Australian dollars, unless otherwise noted.

## 2. Cruise itineraries are not guaranteed

Many factors may affect our ability to provide any particular itinerary. These include weather, mechanical difficulties, civil unrest or other unforeseen circumstances. We agree to use reasonable endeavours to provide a cruise in accordance with our published schedules and itineraries. However, we do not guarantee itineraries and they do not form part of your contract with us. If we are unable to operate in accordance with our published itinerary, we may in some circumstances offer you assistance or compensation in accordance with clause 28.

## 3. Bookings

Each stateroom booked represents an individual booking and can accommodate between one (1) and four (4) guests, depending on the stateroom configuration. Each booking will be allocated a unique booking number.

## 4. Your agreement with us

When you first make a payment towards your cruise holiday, you represent that you have the authority from all guests on your booking(s), to accept our 'Terms & Conditions' on their behalf. Parents/Legal Guardians accept the 'Terms & Conditions' on behalf of their children, including those who travel in a separate stateroom. Once we have received a payment on a booking, an agreement on these 'Terms & Conditions' becomes effective between all guests on the booking(s), Carnival plc and, where applicable, the Carrier.

## 5. Payments

Your booking is not secure until we have received a deposit.

If your deposit as indicated on your booking confirmation is not received within three (3) working days, your booking will be cancelled automatically.

It is essential that you make final payment by the due date and in accordance with the type of fare you have purchased. If payment is not received by the due date, bookings will be automatically cancelled and our 'Cancellation & Refunds' policy will apply in accordance with clause 8. From time to time, we may release promotional fares that have different payment conditions. Please ensure you check the payment conditions at time of booking.

If you are making a booking within the 'Final Payment Due' period of your selected cruise, full payment is required at the time of booking.

## 6. Waitlist Bookings

If your requested cruise or stateroom category is unavailable, you can choose to create a 'waitlist booking'. This means that if your requested cruise or stateroom category becomes available, you will be sent a 'waitlist match' via email. Once sent, you have until the end of the following business day to accept the booking. If accepted, your booking will be subject to our normal Payments and Cancellations & Refunds policies outlined below. There is no deposit required for guests who already have a booking and would like to waitlist for a different stateroom category on any cruise. For a waitlist only booking, a deposit of \$200 per booking is required. If your waitlist is accepted the waitlist deposit paid will contribute to your booking deposit. If you do not accept the waitlist match, or a waitlist match does not become available, the waitlist deposit is fully refundable.

## 7. Travel Insurance

We strongly recommend you purchase appropriate international travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit. As Australian Medicare and New Zealand Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC) do not cover your travel onboard, it is important that international travel insurance is purchased for all voyages (including domestic Australian itineraries which do not visit international ports). If you do not purchase travel insurance, you may not be able to recover cancellation charges, medical costs, repatriation and other expenses that may arise if things do not go according to plan.

## 8. Cancellation & Refunds

Although we would love to see you onboard, we understand that plans can change. Should you need to cancel your booking, we ask that you notify your Travel Agent or our Cruise Contact Centre at your earliest convenience. The refunds or cancellation charges that will be payable depend on the departure date of the Cruise or Cruisetour and the amount of notice you give us, as follows:

We act as agent for the airline carrier in making your flight booking through the Princess EZAir® tool. It is important that you are familiar with your airline's terms and conditions, including important liability limitations. You have the option of booking Restricted Air or Flexible Air. Prices are per person inclusive of all flight taxes and fees except locally payable airport taxes. You should check baggage restrictions with your airline as fees may apply.

### Restricted Air

Changes are not permitted for Restricted Air bookings. In accordance with the terms and conditions of your airline, any changes, including name changes will result in cancellation without refund and require rebooking which may be subject to higher fares. Failure to check in will result in cancellation of your flights, including your return flight.

## Flexible Air

In accordance with airline policy, name changes will not be permitted and will require cancellation and rebooking, which is subject to availability and possibly higher fares. Failure to check in will result in cancellation of your flights, including your return flight, in accordance with airline policy. The following cancellation charges apply to Flexible Air.

### Payments

Payment for Restricted Air is required at time of booking and must be made by credit card. Payment for Flexible Air is due at the final payment due date of your cruise. If you book Flexible Air after the final payment date of your cruise, you will be required to pay at the time of booking by credit card.

Please note that a credit card surcharge of 1.1% for Visa and MasterCard and 2.3% for AMEX, and a 1% surcharge for PayPal applies to payments. The total amount payable for your booking, including any applicable surcharges will be advised to you before you proceed with payment. If booking through a Travel Agent and paying by credit card you will be asked to sign an authorisation form for your agent to provide us with your credit card details to process payment.

### Changes and Cancellations

Please note that cancellation of your air booking does not result in cancellation of your cruise. If you also wish to cancel your cruise please refer to the 'Cancellation and Refunds' section of the Terms and Conditions applicable to your cruise. The guest who appears on the flight booking must be the guest who travels. Cancelling your cruise/cruisetour booking for any reason will cancel any air bookings associated with the cruise/cruisetour, and fees will be applied if applicable.

### Late Arrival Protection

Booking through Princess EZAir® offers you 'Late Arrival Protection'. In the event your flight is delayed, and you are unable to meet the ship in time for embarkation as a result of the delay, we will cover the cost of a replacement commercial flight to the next available port to meet the ship.

Please note, Late Arrival Protection only covers airline delays, it does not cover you if you miss your flight for any other reason. Additionally, if no replacement flight is available due to circumstances such as a severe weather event or natural disaster we will not be required to provide a replacement flight.

Late Arrival Protection will not cover any additional costs such as meals and accommodation as a result of airline delays. Additionally, as airline delays are outside our control, your cruise fare will not be reimbursed in the event you miss part or all or your cruise. For this reason, we strongly recommend you take out comprehensive international travel insurance.

## 10. Changing your cruise holiday

If you choose to change your booking to a different cruise, or to a different sector of a World Cruise, it will be considered as a cancellation of your original booking. In this instance, our cancellation charges, as per our 'Cancellation & Refunds' policy, will apply.

## 11. Your fare

Your fare is determined by the fare type, the number of guests in your stateroom, its location on the ship, the amenities offered, taxes, fees and port expenses, and any applicable airfares including taxes and fees, transfers and hotel accommodation.

The cruise fare includes onboard accommodation, main meals, entertainment, some activities onboard, gym and some fitness classes, as well as taxes, fees and port expenses. A number of optional extras are available that are not included in the cruise fare including drink purchases, some onboard activities, shore tours, shopping, wifi internet, laundry services, day spa services, fitness classes and additional dining options.

## 12. Fare changes

Once booked, your fare is only subject to any increased taxes. You will be notified of this before it is added to your fare or to your onboard account.

Sometimes we will release promotional fares. These can be offered and withdrawn at any time. If after booking you decide to change to one of these promotional fares, you will need to cancel your existing booking and our 'Cancellation & Refunds' policy will apply.

## 13. Stateroom changes

When making a booking with a specific stateroom number, please advise us or your Travel Agent if you do not want your stateroom changed. This means that you will not be offered a complimentary upgrade to a higher priced category, if one was to become available. Please note that your specific stateroom number and bedding configuration can still be changed for operational reasons, including when the number of people booked in the stateroom is less than the number of beds in the stateroom. In addition, when a booking is made and a specific stateroom number is not selected (known as a 'Guarantee'), the stateroom will be allocated at our discretion in the category booked, or a higher priced category, at a later date.

## 14. Fuel supplement

We may elect to impose a fuel supplement at any time, in which case any additional fees will apply to new bookings only. The total price quoted to you at the time of booking will be inclusive of any applicable fuel supplement.

## 15. Booking changes

Once you have made your booking, please check your invoice, 'Cruise Personaliser', or with your Travel Agent to ensure the details are correct. Should you need to make changes to your booking (spelling corrections or to replace a guest\*), no administration fees will apply. Please note however, that additional fees charged by airlines for any changes will be passed onto guests.

\*One original guest from the booking must always remain in the stateroom. If all original guests cancel / are replaced, the booking will be subject to applicable cancellation charges. If a cancelling guest was the only person that qualified the booking for a promotional fare (eg. past guest fare), additional and remaining guests will no longer be entitled to this promotional fare. The booking will revert to a different fare and the remaining guests will need to pay the difference in cost, if any. Changes can only be made up to 48 hours before departure.

## 16. Pregnancy

Guests who are pregnant during their cruise are required to supply a physicians 'fit to travel' note, including your estimated due date, prior to embarkation. We are unable to accept any guests who will have entered their 24th week, or later, of pregnancy by the end of the cruise.

## 17. Minimum age to travel

### Sun Princess®, Sea Princess®, Diamond Princess®, Emerald Princess® and Golden Princess® cruises departing and returning to Australia

To ensure there is suitable supervision, there needs to be at least one guest 18 years or older in each stateroom. However, to accommodate families cruising together, children may occupy a separate stateroom to their parent/legal guardian, providing one child is 16 years or over.

For cruises departing from an Australian port between 1 November and 7 January, any guest under 19 years of age on the day they board the cruise, must travel in the same stateroom as a responsible adult 19 years or older. In addition, from 8 January to 31 January, there is a limit on the number of guests under 19 years of age who can travel unaccompanied. Once the limit is reached, a responsible adult 19 years or older must travel in the same stateroom. We can advise you at the time of booking whether the limit applies to your booking. Princess Cruises can waive the responsible adult requirement at its discretion. The responsible adult is accountable for guests under 19 years of age in their stateroom for the duration of the cruise, and the 'Rights of the Captain' will be applied to anyone who displays disruptive behaviour.

### All other Princess Cruises® ships

To ensure there is suitable supervision, there needs to be at least one guest in each stateroom aged 21 years or older. In order to accommodate families cruising together, children may occupy a separate stateroom to their parent/legal guardian, providing one

## 20. Requirements to travel

Passports, visas, vaccinations and other travel documentation are your responsibility. Without the necessary passport, visas and/or vaccinations local authorities may deny you boarding, prevent you from going ashore, issue a fine or deny the ship entry into the port. It is also your responsibility to ensure you have all the necessary documentation which permits you to travel. If you do not have all the necessary documentation, you may be denied boarding and no refunds will be given.

For international voyages (cruises that visit a foreign port), passports are required for all guests and must be valid for a minimum of six (6) months beyond the date of the cruise return. In addition, travel on our cruises will not revalidate an Australian re-entry visa.

For domestic voyages (cruises that do not visit a foreign port), a valid passport or government issued photo identification is required (Queensland 'Adult Proof of Age Card' will be accepted, however the older version of Queensland 'Card 18+' will not be accepted). For Australian domestic voyages, a current Medicare card can be used for guests under 18 years of age. For New Zealand domestic voyages, an original or certified copy of the child's birth certificate or a school pass with photo will be accepted for guests under 18 years of age.

## 21. Illicit items

To ensure a safe and enjoyable holiday for all our guests, it will be necessary for our staff and other parties, such as port and government agencies, to search you and your luggage. You agree to allow such searches. We can deny boarding or disembark any person in possession of any weapons or illicit substances. You must contact us within three (3) days of disembarking to claim confiscated items which may be returned to you if appropriate. If you do not contact us within this time your item may be destroyed.

## 22. Alcohol & gambling

We are committed to the responsible service of alcohol. There may be times when we consider it appropriate to refuse the service of alcohol to a guest for any reason. To consume alcohol or gamble onboard, the following minimum ages and corkage charges apply:

Government issued photo identification may be requested (Queensland 'Adult Proof of Age Card' will be accepted, however the older version of Queensland 'Card 18+' will not be accepted).

## Bringing alcohol onboard

On the day of embarkation, guests are permitted to bring one 750ml bottle of wine or champagne onboard per voyage, which will not be subject to a corkage fee if consumed in your stateroom. Additional wine or champagne bottles are welcome, but will incur a \$15 corkage fee each, irrespective of where they are intended to be consumed. Liquor, spirits, or beers are not permitted.

Any beverages purchased during the cruise at any port of call will be collected at the gangway for safekeeping and will be delivered to your stateroom on the last day of the cruise. Princess Cruises is not responsible for any alcoholic beverages confiscated by local security staff. These items are not eligible for monetary refund or replacement.

## 23. Smoking

Smoking is not permitted indoors on any of our ships. This includes in staterooms and on private balconies. For those who smoke, there are designated outdoor areas where smoking is permitted and this information will be communicated to you onboard. Electronic cigarettes can only be used in the designated smoking areas onboard.

## 24. Your health

We care about the health and safety of our guests. To assist, please advise us at the time of booking if you have any existing condition that requires medical attention, medication or special treatment. If you have an existing medical condition, we may ask you to complete a health questionnaire. If a guest has an existing condition that we decide may seriously affect the enjoyment, health or safety of themselves or any other person onboard, we can refuse or cancel a booking, where necessary. We will give reasonable consideration when reaching this decision and will advise you as soon as possible. As long as you have provided us with a completed health questionnaire with all relevant information about the condition, you will be entitled to a full refund if we cancel your booking on the basis of this condition.

Guests that need assistance should always be accompanied by a carer to help with day to day activities as our crew and medical staff are unable to act as personal carers.

## 25. Onboard medical centre

The Princess Cruises<sup>®</sup> medical centres are staffed by fully registered and licensed doctors and nurses who are available 24 hours a day in case of an emergency. Our facilities are well equipped to deal with both minor injuries and most major medical conditions. Please note, our facilities are only for medical needs arising onboard and cannot cater for treatments that you know you will require while on holiday.

All Princess Cruises<sup>®</sup> medical facilities proudly hold the distinction of being the only medical services in the cruise industry to have been awarded accreditation to international healthcare standards as well as certification to ISO 9001:2008. We are not a healthcare provider and may not be held liable for the sickness, injury or death of any guest arising from any advice, treatment, care, services or any omission by medical staff. These medical providers exercise their own medical judgement and expertise.

## 26. Onboard medical charges

All cruises on our ships are outside the scope of Australian Medicare, New Zealand Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC) and private health insurance. Consultations, treatments and medications are charged at private rates and must be paid by you and claimed through your travel insurance.

## 27. Other service providers

While we specialise in cruising holidays, you may choose to book other services with us such as flights, accommodation, transfers and shore excursions. We can assist you in making these arrangements; however, we act only as a booking agent. The service providers are solely responsible for the information and service offered and their conditions will apply. Where possible, we will assist in addressing any concerns you may have with the service providers. Any arrangements made by or for you are your responsibility and entirely at your own risk.

Please note, airline terms and conditions may require full non-refundable payment prior to Princess Cruises' normal payment conditions.

## 28. Ship & itinerary changes

We will do everything we reasonably can to make sure everything goes according to plan; however, sometimes changes can happen that may affect your holiday experience. This could include weather, mechanical difficulties, civil unrest or any other unforeseen circumstances.

In addition, we may charter all or part of the ship, or remove the ship from service where this becomes necessary. We may change the itinerary, ship or cancel the cruise due to operational or commercial requirements. We will notify you of these changes as soon as we can. If we are forced to cancel your cruise for any reason prior to departure we will provide a full refund. Since your itinerary is not guaranteed, please do not make any important arrangements or meetings based on the proposed itinerary.

### Changes within our control

Where we make a significant change to the ports in your itinerary prior to departure and this is due to a circumstance within our control, for example for operational or commercial requirements you will have the choice of:

1. the new itinerary;
2. an alternative cruise of comparable standard, if available; or
3. cancelling the cruise for a full refund of your fare paid.

For the purposes of this clause, 'significant change' means a change to the city of departure or disembarkation, or to the majority (by number) of the other ports in your itinerary.

### Changes outside our control

If it is necessary to change the itinerary due to safety, maritime law, severe weather, to protect human life or health or other factors outside our control, we will attempt to offer a revised itinerary as close as possible to the original itinerary. We will not provide any compensation in connection with the revised itinerary unless consumer laws require otherwise.

## 29. Travel Restrictions and Rights of the Captain

You are responsible for ensuring that no travel restrictions apply to you. If police or any other authority in any jurisdiction notify us of, or we otherwise become aware of, any matter that reasonably causes us to believe your presence onboard presents a risk to your own health or safety or the health or safety of other guests and crew, we, or the Captain, may deny you boarding. A full refund of a guest's cruise fare will be provided to any guest denied boarding on this basis.

Once the cruise has commenced, if a guest seriously affects the safety, well-being or enjoyment of themselves or any other person onboard, the Captain has the right to confine, sedate or disembark the guest. In such cases, we are not responsible for any expenses including your return home. In addition, you will not be entitled to any refunds. While the Captain will always act reasonably in these circumstances, you accept that the safety, well-being and enjoyment of everyone onboard, comes first. You agree not to solicit other Guests for commercial purposes or advertise goods or services onboard the ship without our prior written permission.

## 30. Leaving the cruise early

If you are required, or choose, to leave the cruise for any reason (unless caused by our proven negligence or failure to provide services with due care and skill and that are reasonably fit for purpose), we are not responsible for any expenses, including your return home. This also applies if you do not return to the ship in time for sailing after a port visit. If we assist you with any costs, you will need to repay us on your return. In addition, you will not be entitled to any refunds.

## 31. Limitation of liability for Recreational Services

Save for liability for significant personal injury caused by Reckless Conduct by us or our servants or agents, we exclude liability for all Excluded Recreational Liabilities arising out of the supply of Recreational Services.

## 32. Time limits for claims

You agree to use all reasonable efforts to report any complaints or claims onboard, or otherwise bring the matter to our attention as soon as possible. You acknowledge that failure to bring any matter to our attention whilst onboard will limit our ability to investigate the matter following your cruise.

Where consumer laws and other laws permit us to exclude our liability, we will not be liable for:

- loss of, or damage to, any luggage or other belongings
- sickness, injury or death, unless caused by our proven negligence or failure to provide services with due care and skill and that are reasonably fit for purpose.

In addition, our liability will be reduced in proportion to any negligence or fault on your part.

## 33. Severability

These Booking and Passage Conditions must, so far as possible, be interpreted and construed so as not to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, but if a provision, on its true interpretations or construction is held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable:

- a) that provision must so far as possible, be read down to the extent that it may be necessary to ensure that it is not illegal, invalid or unenforceable and as may be reasonable in all the circumstances so as to give it a valid operation; or
- b) if the provision or part of it cannot effectively be read down, that provision or part of it will be deemed to be void and severable and the remaining provisions of these Booking and Passage Conditions will not in any way be affected or impaired and will continue notwithstanding that illegality, invalidity or unenforceability.

## 34. Choice of law & jurisdiction

This contract is governed by the laws in force in New South Wales. You agree that any action you bring against us will be brought in New South Wales, Australia.

If you have a claim against us, you agree only to bring action against us and not any of our related bodies corporate as defined in the Corporations Act 2001(Cth).

## 35. Privacy

Privacy laws safeguard your personal details.

### Security Cameras

For the safety and security of our guests and crew, we use Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) to monitor and record public areas onboard all our ships. This footage is confidential and is not available for viewing, unless required or permitted by law. We are not responsible for any consequences arising from the viewing or other use of this footage.

### Personal Information

During the booking process and your cruise holiday, we ask for personal information about you. By providing this information, you authorise us to handle your personal information in the ways indicated below:

- to collect personal information within the meaning of the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) about you:
  - from any third party making a booking on your behalf for cruise administration purposes;
  - if you are travelling as part of a group – from any person in the group for cruise administration purposes;
  - from any third party where it is necessary to provide a health service to you (including a medical disembarkation) and you are unable to provide the information directly;
  - for security purposes;
  - for accident/incident reporting, investigation and management purposes;
  - Where lawful and reasonably necessary to perform our functions or activities, we may be required to collect sensitive information including, information about health, race and criminal record.
- to disclose your personal information:
  - to our service providers, including mailing houses, ticketing companies, marketing agencies, emergency response providers, claims processors and lawyers for the purpose of enabling them to provide relevant services.
  - to our customer database service providers which are located in the United States and India

- to related entities within the Carnival group of companies (headquartered in the United States and the United Kingdom with registered branch offices in Australia, New Zealand and Japan) for cruise administration and business operation purposes;

- to your travel agent for cruise administration purposes, including any information relating to travel bans;
- where you book as part of a group – to every guest in your group (excluding credit card details);
- to an emergency contact person you have nominated for emergency management purposes;
- to government departments/agencies/bodies responsible for customs, immigration, ports, quarantine and law enforcement, including police In Australia, New Zealand and each of the ports in your itinerary, for reporting purposes;

Where lawful we may also be required to disclose sensitive information about you to the entities listed above.

- to use and disclose your personal information, and, where lawful, your sensitive information:

- for product research and development purposes, including conducting past guest surveys;
- for sending you information about our products and services, including by email and messaging services such as SMS, and to us contacting you by telephone and fax (you may request to be removed from our contact lists at any time);
- for reporting, assessing, investigating, processing and otherwise managing accidents/incidents, including disclosures to lawyers and insurers;
- for public health and quarantine purposes;
- for medical treatment (including medical disembarkation) purposes, including disclosures to health service providers, medical evacuation assistance companies, hotels, airlines, travel agents and, where you are unable to consent, next of kin.

- where your onboard expenses are charged to someone else's credit card – to deliver onboard account statements regarding those expenses to the credit card holder;

- where we need to disclose your personal information to someone who is not in Australia – to transfer your personal information outside Australia;

- where we need to disclose your health information to someone who is not in New South Wales or to a Commonwealth agency – to transfer your health information outside New South Wales or to the Commonwealth agency;

- in the event that you lodge a complaint or claim about any matter with or in relation to us – to use and disclose your personal information for the purpose of reporting, assessing, investigating, processing, responding to and resolving your complaint or claim, including disclosures to relevant government departments/agencies/bodies, courts/tribunals, your travel agent, any authorised representative acting on your behalf and lawyers. You also authorise us to collect from any third party sensitive information about you within the meaning of the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth), and for any third party to disclose personal information about you to us, for the above-mentioned purpose.

In these terms and conditions:


- "Australian Consumer Law" means schedule 2 of the CCA and any equivalent state or territory legislation;
