





Day 1 - UK/Vancouver

Fly to Vancouver for an overnight stay.

Day 2 - Vancouver/Whitehorse

Fly to Whitehorse and experience the Yukon capital, home of the ss Klondike and more.

Day 3 - Whitehorse/Dawson City

Travel by motorcoach to Dawson City, a 19th century restored gold rush town once dubbed the "Paris of the North".

Day 8 - Denali Tundra Wilderness Tour


