We're setting our sights on a plastic-free future. We're in the process of banning more than 60 types of single-use plastics-including straws, water bottles and bags-across all operations. We are constantly working with our suppliers to avoid plastic wrapping on goods and find more ways to eliminate waste onboard.

SUSTAINABLE FOOD REDUCTION ONBOARD

Food waste is one of the largest contributors to climate change, which is why we've partnered with **Leanpath**, a food waste management company, to reduce our carbon footprint. Their system measures the quantity of food discarded after every meal onboard. With these precise measurements, our chefs will have the necessary data and confidence to prepare the perfect amount of each dish. Since first implementing Leanpath, Uniworld has prevented 25,000 kg of food waste, thereby avoiding the emission of nearly 200 tonnes of carbon across the eleven ships currently using the system, as of April 2023. Uniworld was, in fact, the first river cruise line to introduce this kind of food waste reduction system to our fleet.
