De luxe original cabin Nº 8 (Cat. B)

The main deck with the original cabins contains the soul of the SEA CLOUD. This is also recognizable in details such as the interior staircase that connects the main deck with the promenade deck, providing guests with direct access to the restaurant and lounge. The design is based on historical models with a contemporary accent and is kept in warm fabrics and wood tones. Both cabins are located at the end of the original area and are connected to the promenade deck by a separate staircase. Special features: walk-in closet, generous storage space.

Double-bed cabins Nº 30 and 31 (Cat. 1)

Like all the cabins on the captain's and lido deck, these two rooms were built as recently as the late 1970s and offer a great deal of comfort. Their outstanding feature is the panoramic windows placed at the corners, creating a bright and friendly atmosphere.

Twin-bed cabins Nº 32-37 (Cat. 2)

Their tasteful interior design is a contemporary interpretation of the interior designed by Marjorie Merriweather in the 1930s.

But the due to its location on the promenade deck also ensures that the cabins are only one step away from the restaurant and lounge in the superstructure amidships. Cabins No 20 and 21 have a slightly different floor plan.
